Section 1 of the plan has been approved by the Inspector and is expected to be approved by TDC full council shortly. This includes approval for 9000 homes on the Colchester/Tendring

boundary. The approval means that the 550 per annum housing supply number is now final and that Tendring has a 6.5 year housing supply. The outcome of this is that two appeals have already been dismissed and that further applications for speculative development are less likely. Section 2 of the plan will be examined by the Inspector in February and a decision expected by the end of the year. This section will contain the detailed matters relating to the area.
