WEELEY RECREATION GROUND

CONDITIONS OF USE

1. Prior permission for events must always be sought from the Council. The Council reserves the right to refuse permission without giving reasons.
2. All hire charges and/or fees must be paid in advance of the event.
3. The council reserves the right to rescind permission if it considers the ground conditions are unsuitable and could lead to damage of the field.
4. The Council reserves the right to rescind permission if it considers the event could cause public order concerns or for any other reason.
5. The Council accepts no liability for any costs of any sort arising out of a decision to rescind the permission or to cancel the event.
6. Hirers must hold Third Party Liability insurance cover for a minimum of £5 million and must indemnify the Council against any claim arising out of the event.
7. You must carry out risk assessments for your event and ensure and take action to mitigate all identified hazards and risks.
8. You must ensure there are sufficient stewards/marshals/other officials present to ensure good public order.
9. Your activities must not cause unreasonable disturbance to nearby residents or other users of the area. The event must finish by 9pm.
10. Vehicle access gates to the field must be kept locked or manned at all times during the event, and all gates must be securely locked at its conclusion.
11. No vehicles may be taken on to the field unless prior arrangements have been agreed by the Council.
12. All litter, signs, objects etc must be cleared from the field immediately after the event and the area left clean and tidy.
13. The hirer is responsible for any reinstatement or replacement required by damage caused to the area, its vegetation or artefacts.
