## WEELEY RECREATION GROUND CONDITIONS OF USE

- Prior permission for events must always be sought from the Council. The Council reserves the right to refuse permission without giving reasons.
- 2. All hire charges and/or fees must be paid in advance of the event.
- 3. The council reserves the right to rescind permission if it considers the ground conditions are unsuitable and could lead to damage of the field.
- 4. The Council reserves the right to rescind permission if it considers the event could cause public order concerns or for any other reason.
- The Council accepts no liability for any costs of any sort arising out of a decision to rescind the permission or to cancel the event.
- Hirers must hold Third Party Liability insurance cover for a minimum of £5 million and must indemnify the Council against any claim arising out of the event.
- You must carry out risk assessments for your event and ensure and take action to mitigate all identified hazards and risks.
- You must ensure there are sufficient stewards/marshals/other officials present to ensure good public order.
- 9. Your activities must not cause unreasonable disturbance to nearby residents or other users of the area. The event must finish by 9pm.
- 10. Vehicle access gates to the field must be kept locked or manned at all times during the event, and all gates must be securely locked at its conclusion.
- 11. No vehicles may be taken on to the field unless prior arrangements have been agreed by the Council.
- 12. All litter, signs, objects etc must be cleared from the field immediately after the event and the area left clean and tidy.
- 13. The hirer is responsible for any reinstatement or replacement required by damage caused to the area, its vegetation or artefacts.
