

PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014

DOG CONTROL and DOG FOULING

A Public Spaces Protection Order is in place for the Tendring District as highlighted in the red area shown on the map below.







- (1) A person in charge of a dog shall comply with a direction given to him by an authorised person to put and keep the dog on a lead.
- (2) If a dog defecates at any time on land to which the public or any section of the public has access, on payment or otherwise, as of right or by virtue of express or implied permission then the person who is in charge of the dog at the time shall remove the faeces from the land forthwith.

Breach of this order, without reasonable excuse is a criminal offence, subject to a FIXED PENALTY (of £100) or PROSECUTION
